



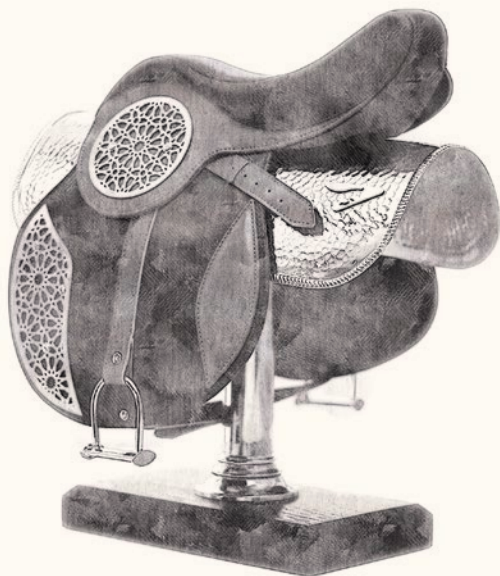

Casablanca-Anfa racecourse :

Built in 1912, Casablanca-Anfa racecourse is the oldest racecourse in Morocco. Spanning over a 20 hectares area and located in the heart of the economic city of the Kingdom, it features a covered grandstand with 1700 meter long dirt track.



Bouskoura Training Center :

Located on the outskirts of Casablanca in the heart of the green city of Bouskoura on an area of 87 hectares, the Bouskoura Training Center aims to be as a locomotive of the horse industry by providing horse racing facilities in the Casablanca region.

The Bouskoura Training Center includes :

- 400 boxes for racehorses
- Several training tracks, gallop, trotting and canter of 1700 linear meter in length
- Several outdoor rides and quarries
- 1 Pony Club
- 1 farriery center
- 2 restaurants
- Collective housing and a catering area

Entry

1. Date of entries :

- Entry : from October 10th to 31st before 11 AM GMT+1.
- Probable starters : November 11th before 11 AM GMT +1
- Supplementary entries : November 11th before 5 PM GMT +1
- Final list : November 12th before 12 PM GMT+1

2. Entry documentation required :

- Entries form
- Proof of entry payment
- Foreign Performance Report
- Copy of the passeport
- RCN
- Bank Details (name of the beneficiary, copy passeport, IBAN, SWIFT code, the name of the bank and its address)

Subsidies and incentives

1. Horse Transportation :

- Shipment of horses will be arranged by The Société Royale d'Encouragement du cheval (SOREC).
- A 20-seater plane will be available for the transport of horses. The SOREC reserves the right to allocate seats for air transport according to the rating value of participating horses.
- The departure airport for the horses will be communicated later.
- The costs of transporting the horse to the assembly point are borne by the participants.
- Trainer's staff are not permitted to accompany horses on the flight.
- A transportation allowance is awarded to horses coming overland : Spain 2000 € / France 2500 € / UK & Irlande 3000 €.
- The horses will stay at Bouskoura Training center (15 minutes from Casablanca airport and 30 minutes from the racecourse).
- The horse feed is the responsibility of the participants

2. Program and Hospitality :

Program :

November 18th	Arrival of participants
November 19th	Thoroughbred international racing day- Gala Diner

November 21st	Departure of participants

Hotel and shuttles :

- The Société Royale d'Encouragement du Cheval (SOREC) will provide air tickets and hotel from 18th to November 21st for the owner, the trainer and the jockey.
- All grooms will stay at Bouskoura Training Center.
- The Shuttles organized by SOREC are :
 - Casablanca Airport/Hotel
 - Racecourse/Hotel
 - Hotel/Traning Center (18th, 19th and November 20th)

HEALTH & Customs Formalities

For the temporary admission of horses participating in the Morocco International Meeting, the transit formalities and the main documents to be prepared are :

1. Health record :

Health certificate and laboratory analysis :

All horses must have a veterinary health certificate validated by the official veterinary service, and originals of test reports. In addition to the usual certifications on the sanitary and epidemiological state of the country and / or the holding of provenance, the veterinary health certificate include the laboratory analysis.

For most European countries, with which we have sanitary agreements, there are 2 analyzes that are requested :

- The test of Equine Infectious Anemia (Coggins test within 30 days of loading)
- The test of Equine Viral Arteritis at the intervals indicated ; within 21 days (Spain) or 28 days (France) of loading (Serum neutralisation test) with a second test within 14 days for horses regularly vaccinated against this disease.

Additional analyzes may be requested, under certain conditions :

- Dourine (the complement fixation test) 10 days before boarding.
- Glanders (the complement fixation test) 10 days before boarding.
- The horses coming from UAE and Qatar have in addition a test of African horse sickness.
- According to European regulations, it will be necessary to do an additional analysis for the Surra.

Vaccination :

Horses must be properly vaccinated against two diseases :

- Equine influenza
- Equine Viral Rhinopneumonitis

2. Customs formalities :

All horses and equipment must be recorded in an ATA carnet, available at chambers of commerce. The ATA Carnet is obligatory because it allows to dispense with taxes and the deposit of the import bond. The conveyance must be equipped with the <<MA authorization>> available at the transport department. If this conveyance is included in the ATA carnet, this authorization may not be requested. It is strongly recommended that copies of the documents be forwarded in advance to freight forwarders and / or the organization, to ensure validity and to provide control and transit in the best conditions. Facilities and assistance will be put in place at the border post in order to ensure a smooth transit
